

On June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2015, members of the Swissvale Shade Tree Committee attended the Swissvale Farmers Market to survey residents about trees. The survey was developed with the help of Jared Manzo, the Greenlinks Coordinator from the Nine Mile Run Watershed Association.

25 homeowners were surveyed.

Less than half surveyed have street trees but about half indicated an interest in getting a street tree. More than half surveyed have private trees on their property. Residents saw benefits from trees including:

- increasing their property value
- improving air quality
- providing shade and decreasing utility bills
- reducing storm water runoff.

About half of the residents feel the borough needs more trees.

The biggest challenges indicated by residents were:

- sidewalk damage
- interfering with overhead utility lines
- tree pruning and maintenance

There seemed to be a willingness from residents to get involved with tree plantings and care.

From the results of the survey the SSTAC would like to:

- Educate residents about the benefits of an urban canopy-shade, beauty, storm water control, utility bills, increase in property value, health benefits
- Work to insure that proper trees are planted as street trees
- Promote tree care through advocacy, outreach, and education
- Work closely with the DPW insure care and maintenance of street trees
- Develop a current inventory of Swissvale Borough trees
- Identify institutions from which grants may be obtained to help to finance the needs of trees in Swissvale
